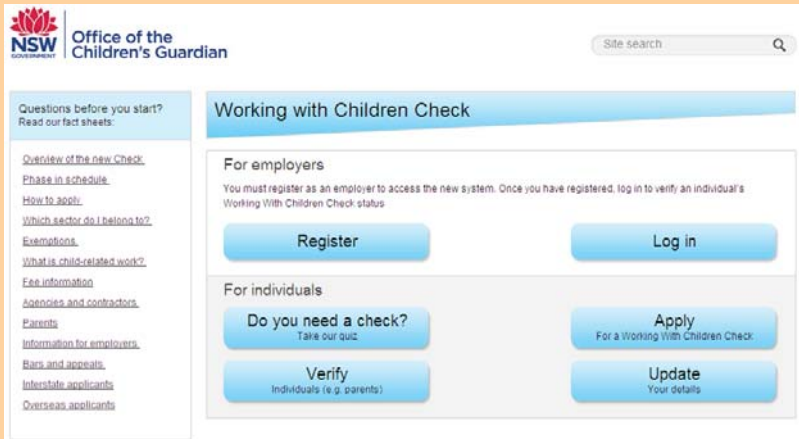

Complete all fields including selecting “**Purpose for check**” of “**Clubs or Other bodies...**” as below:

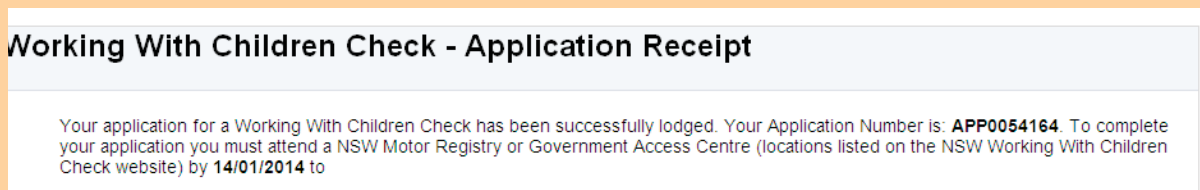
Purpose for check *

You will be emailed a confirmation of your application which looks like this:



2. Take this notice to your local RTA centre together with the identification form you nominated - Drivers Licence / ID card. Staff at the RTA will confirm you are the person in the notice.
3. A few hours later you will be emailed a confirmation letter that your application has been processed, which includes a **WWC number** on letterhead like this:
