
## A MESSAGE FROM BRIGHTER FUTURES

There is a story that Archimedes, the Greek mathematician, was asked to find out if the new golden crown of the king was made of pure gold, while keeping the crown intact. Sitting in a public bath and thinking about it, Archimedes noticed the displacement of the water caused by sinking his body lower into the water. He suddenly realized that he had found the solution: if the crown was made of pure gold, it should displace the same volume of water as a bar of pure gold with an equal weight. Excited, he jumped out of the bath and ran home shouting "Eureka!", forgetting that he was still naked...

Archimedes discovered the first law of hydrostatics: when a body is immersed in a fluid, it experiences an upward buoyant force, which is equal to the weight of the fluid displaced by the immersed part of the body.

In an aquarium filled with water, a block of ice floats. We mark the current water level.

When the ice has melted completely, will the water level be higher, lower, or still the same?
