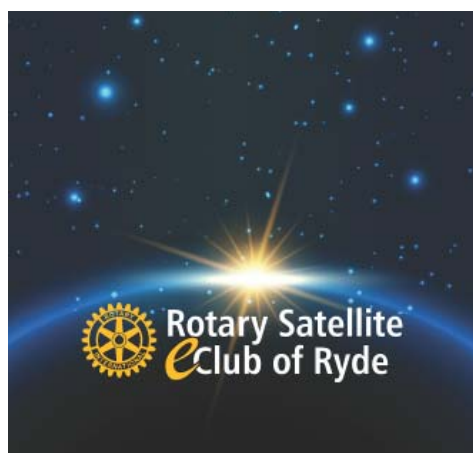

En route from Edinburgh to Skye, dentist Iain Corran from the Rotary Club of Bakewell in Derbyshire joined us at our lunch meeting on 8th April to brief club members on progress with the assembly of £50,000 of grant funding required to train rural healthcare workers in Tanzania in basic oral healthcare dentistry skills - essentially injection and extraction - taking out teeth with abscesses.

Tanzania in East Africa, one of the poorest countries in the world, has escaped many of the destabilising events prevalent in the adjacent nations of Uganda and Rwanda. Until the 1960s dental decay was virtually unknown in East Africa. The introduction of sugary beverages and western-style confectionary has changed all that.

With a population of 45 million, 75 per cent of whom live in the rural outback, Tanzania needs support to quickly and effectively address this problem. Rotary’s aim is to help provide basic dentistry coverage at a rate of 1 rural healthcare worker for every 10,000 people. So far, 358 rural healthcare workers have been successfully trained, so there is a long way to go.

The funding package that Iain is co-ordinating involves a range of grant sources including local, district, UK and international Rotary funding. Decisions on the grant applications will be made later this year.

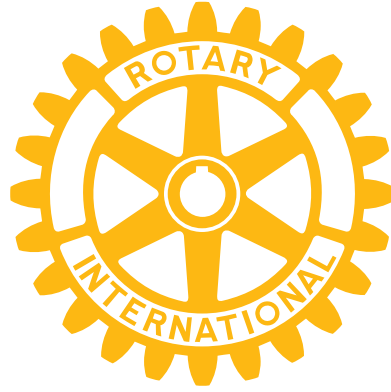
