The night of nights was upon us: the 2018 Ryde Rotary Club Police Officer of the Year Awards. An opportunity to recognise our everyday heroes and valuable members of our community. Our own Serjeant-at-Arms, **Alan Oertel**, called to order the meeting before **President John Brown** welcomed everyone to the evening. **PP Ken Allen** led the grace before **PP Stephen Thorp** toasted to Rotary International and **DG Peter Ward** responded. **DGE Susan Wakefield**, **John Wakefield**, and **DGN Kalma McLellan** were the also in attendance, as well as Rotarians, friends and family, our award nominees and their families, and other members of the Ryde Police Area Command.

A hearty beef and vegetables dish was served as extended fellowship was enjoyed. John Brown, relieved of duties on this evening, called to the front our MC for the evening: **Ayesha Jadhvani**. Ayesha welcomed everyone before highlighting the importance of the Police Awards and quoted words from past NSW Police Force Commissioner, **Andrew Scipione**. Ayesha then introduced our guest speaker for the evening: Detective Inspector **Glyndwr Baker**. Glyn, who has stepped in at Ryde Police Area Command, thanked Ryde Rotary Club for hosting this event. He touched on how there is more than 200 staff at Ryde Police Area Command and there's a variety of teams within the Command that tackle the big issues around the community.

It was then time for the presentation of the certificates to our three award recipients. The first was Uniformed Officer of the Year, Leading Senior Constable **Toby Hopkins**. Starting with the Eastwood Unit in 2008, Toby has remained there ever since. He's the first responder at the unit who consistently goes above and beyond his duties. Toby is regularly entrusted to step in to team leader roles and is a well deserving recipient of this year's award.

Our second award recipient was for the Plain Clothes Officer of the Year: Senior Constable **Terence Wilson**. Starting in 2011, Terence was then transferred to Ryde PAC in 2014 and promoted to the proactive crime team in 2017, as a result of his skills. Terence is “diligent and thorough” in his position. Upon receiving this accolade, Terence said that it is “always good to be recognised for the good work you do”.

Our final award recipient was for an unsung hero: Unsworn Officer of the Year, **Robyn Cuddy**. In the introduction of this award, Kalma spoke of how there are people always behind the events who do a lot of good work...an organisation cannot get by without them”. Robyn has moved to different units since commencing in 1996, before finding herself at Ryde PAC in 2014. Robyn demonstrates exceptional customer skills, internally within the organisation and externally to others. This was particularly evident when she was tasked with the high level skill of rostering over New Years, especially when this wasn't her role at the time.

A sickly sweet dessert dish was served as some more fellowship was shared. It was then that Glyn and John Brown presented the 2018 Ryde Rotary Club Police Officer of the Year Award, to Toby Hopkins of Ryde PAC. The National Anthem was sung before the Awards night was closed for this year.
